## **What do you do with your tiddlers?**

The Messy Church team is very appreciative of all the support given by the church. This enables us to reach out to so many families in our community. Each year a donation of £100 is sent to the Bible Reading Fellowship (BRF) which oversees and co-ordinates all the work of Messy Church around the world. It is estimated that 500,000 people of all ages attend Messy Church each month! The aim of BRF is to transform lives and communities. It runs the 'Barnabas in Schools' scheme providing RE days to over 25,000 children each year. There is also a section of BRF that works with older people - usually about 10,000 each month. There is also 'Vintage Messy Church' and 'Who let the Dads out?'. BRF provides support to each section to enable them to work within our communities here in the UK and further afield. This year they have launched 'Transforming lives with spare change' and I have a number of collecting boxes if you would like to support them.
